# **Rural Rother Youth Forum**

## Information about the Forum

### **What is the Rural Rother Youth Forum?**

RRYF is a body that aims to work on the issues facing Young People who live rurally and those that work with them or care about the issues that affect them. The Forum covers the whole of rural Rother excluding the area of Bexhill. RRYF is a membership organization and has members from across sectors and with a range of interests.

### **What does the Forum do?**

The Forum works on many levels. We aim to work by

- arranging networking events for members where we can exchange ideas and discuss common concerns and how we might remedy them
- taking the lessons from our membership and forming them into projects
- seeking influence and to raise rural issues amongst decision makers and statutory bodies
- looking for funding to run work with Young People or volunteers in rural Rother
- keeping the local communities of rural Rother aware of the issues facing Young People
- looking at how local and national policies affect Young People in rural Rother
- helping local Young People to make their needs clear to those that make decisions

We work on these aims with our membership and partners and are always open to new ideas of how to achieve our aims.

### **Who runs the Forum?**

The Forum is run by an Executive Group elected by members at the Annual General Meeting. This Executive includes representatives from local health bodies, local government, voluntary agencies and County Council services, including Parish, District and County Councillors, Members of the Youth Parliament, and those involved in local action for Young People.

### **Who can be a member of the Forum?**

Anyone with an interest in the issues for Young People in rural Rother can be a member of the forum, contribute via RRYF networks and events, and be part of projects that we initiate. Membership of RRYF is free.

### **What does the Forum offer organisations who are members?**

RRYF offers organisations who are members the chance to pass on their learning to decision-makers, the opportunity to discuss the rural element of their work, and the chance to be part of a broader group with shared aims for the area and for Young People.

### **How does the Forum fit in to other groups?**

Through our membership and the RRYF Executive the Forum has strong links with many other groups working on Young People's issues and rural issues, both in the statutory and voluntary sector. The Forum is well-placed to raise rural issues in many different decision-making groups.
