The County Council has recently made formal representations to Network Rail on their Electrification, Kent and Sussex Route Utilisation Strategies (RUSs).

I am aware that various concerns have been raised regarding the content of the Sussex and Kent RUSs and their implications for East Sussex. Due to the widespread nature of these concerns, we believe an opportunity should be presented for representatives to discuss these key issues in a wider forum. The subsequent outcome of this would be a collective response to Network Rail and the Department for Transport, which would further strengthen the previous comments submitted in response to the RUSs formal consultation process.

Accordingly, on 27 November 2009, I would like to invite you to a conference hosted by the County Council on the RUSs. As space is limited, only one representative from your organisation is invited to attend.

Network Rail has agreed to attend and make a presentation at this conference, ahead of publication of the final strategies in the New Year.

The conference will be held in the Hardwick Suite at the International Lawn Tennis Centre in Eastbourne, commencing at 9:30am and finishing at 13.00pm, after which lunch will be provided.
