Rye Town Council very kindly gave Tilling Green Residents Association a grant of £3,500 for IT equipment which would be based at Tilling Green Community Centre for community use. So far we have purchased a projector and screen and it was planned that we should also purchase some computers for training purposes. Rye Partnership has been given several computers which they plan on using for this very purpose at the Centre.

An item which we feel would be of great use to the Tilling Green Residents Association would be a Notice Board. One of the things we find difficult is to get our meetings and events advertised. We were wondering if it would be acceptable with Rye Town Council if spent – up to say £500 of the Rye Town Council grant money – on a decent sized notice board that would stand just inside the gates of the Centre.
