Operating times of the toilets in Rye are as follows: -

Lucknow Place and The Strand

Open by 08:00
Closed @ 18:00 October 01 - March 31
Closed @ 20:00 April 01 - May 31
Closed @ 22:00 June 01 - September 30

Station Approach and Gun Garden

Open by 08:00 generally but 09:00 during the school term
Closed generally in accordance with the closing times listed above but during the school term Station Approach closed @ 16:30 and Gun Garden @ 17:00

Hope that clarifies things.

With regard to Station Approach I have listed the requirements of our contract, but in practice we have found the need to close these a little earlier to avoid damage.
