I have been liaising with Brian Banks from ESCC Highways regarding the erection of a TIC sign to direct pedestrians up Lion Street from the High Street. At the bottom of Lion Street there is a lamp post which a TIC sign could easily be erected to.

Brian has asked me to liaise with Rother's conservation officers and Rye Town Council in terms of having input in to the final design of any sign.

I have attached the examples that Brian has sent through to me and my preference would be for one of the 1st Two options which state Tourist Information with the 'i'. RDC's conservation officers are happy with the standard sign and I would be grateful if you could let me know if the Town Council would like to comment on the final design?

Brian also indicated that he has recently been discussing the provision of Brown Signage in and around Rye with the Town Council, particularly focusing on the Landgate area. Has anything progressed with these plans?

Also is there any update on the erection of the additional Tourist Information Finger Posts?
