Rye Deli	1 board on own ground
Johnsons Fruiterers	Excessive trading on pavement. Impeding the carriageway
Southern Cross Travel	Flat board Protruding slightly
Crispins	Trading on pavement (Trolley of shoes)
Claristo	Board leaning on wall – identical to fixed wall board.

The Ship Inn	A board on pavement but not obstructing as unused section
Baileys	Clutter of boards – two in road covering double Yellow Lines
Tambuka	1 board leaning on iron bollard
Rye Heritage Centre	3 boards – one protruding around a corner of pavement
Kettle of Fish	A board blocking pavement. Owners car parked on pavement
