

All

Following on from the Harbour of Rye Advisory Committee meeting last Friday I attach a view of a brick flower bed that the Environment Agency intends to construct on the Strand Quay adjacent the flood defence wall on the town side. This raised oblong shaped brick structure will be approximately 5 metres in length 0.7 metres high and extending a further 0.8 metres in width. Presently the Agency is committed to build one although ideally 3 would be better, placed between existing seating arrangements. I have been requested to enquire whether there might be funding from either the RDC or the Rye Town Council and their funding partners to enable further beds to be built. Price quoted for 1 is in the region of £2,869. When constructed a contract will be put in place for the planting and maintenance of suitable flora to enhance this important tourist attraction of the town.
