

- Service 311 Pett-Icklesham-Rye
 Schooldays only
 Operated by Rambler Coaches
 This service will continue unchanged.
- Service 312 Rye-Idon-Wittersham-Tenterden
 Mondays to Saturdays
 Operated by Coastal Coaches with low floor easy access buses
 The Monday to Friday service is improved to hourly and the Saturday service is revised and some journeys extended to Broad Oak to compensate for the withdrawal of Service 300.
- Service 318 Heathfield Town Service-Heathfield-Framfield-Uckfield
 319 Heathfield-Burwash-Etchingham-Hurst Green
 Mondays to Saturdays
 Operated by Renown Coaches
 The Monday to Friday service is completely revised and generally improved to operate once again as a through service continuing from Hurst Green to Hawkhurst. The service will also benefit from two early and late journeys between Broad Oak and Hawkhurst operated by Countryliner with the buses used on new Service 304/305. The Saturday service is unchanged. All journeys will normally be operated with low floor easy access buses.
- Service 319 Eastbourne-Bexhill-Claverham College
 Schooldays only
 To be operated by Renown Coaches
 Renumbered 321 and revised to start from Upper Bamhorn (Little Common) instead of Eastbourne.
- Service 326 Rye Town Service
 Mondays to Fridays
 Operated by Rye Community Transport
 This service is generally revised and some journeys extended to Broad Oak to replace the withdrawn Service 300.
- Service 328 Battle-Bexhill College
 Operated by Autopoint on College Days only
 Incorporated into Service 395
- Service 347 Pett-West Hill-Hastings-Conquest Hospital
 Mondays to Fridays
 To be operated by Coastal Coaches and Stagecoach who will operate the peak hour journeys and Coastal the off peak, both using low floor easy access buses.
 The section of route between Hastings Town Centre and Conquest Hospital is withdrawn, and the Hastings to Pett section is improved to hourly and co-ordinated with Stagecoach Service 28 to give a half

hourly service to West Hill. Return tickets issued by one operator will be accepted by the other on common sections of route.

- Service 349 Hastings-Sedlescombe-Bodiam-Hawkhurst
Mondays to Saturdays
To be operated by Stagecoach with a new low floor easy access bus
This service replaces Service 254 and is reduced to operate every two hours but with an extra bus at 1745 from Hastings to maintain a facility for workers and students.
- Service 355 Heathfield - Dallington - Battle (some journeys - Hastings)
Mondays to Fridays.
To be operated by Countryliner
This service is revised to operate every two hours and the section of route between Battle and Hastings is withdrawn. Service will operate to Marley Gardens to replace Service 395. A low floor easy access bus will normally be used.
- Service 356 Hoe-Ashburnham-Claverham College
Schooldays only
To be operated by Renown Coaches
The section of route to Mountfield in the afternoon is transferred to Service 355

Generally unchanged but the sections to Bexhill College are withdrawn.

To be operated by Rambler Coaches
The extra inter peak journeys are withdrawn
- Service 361 Rye Harbour-Northiam-Broad Oak-Bexhill College
College days only
Operated by Renown Coaches
Revised to start from Playden
- Service 362 Rye Harbour-Sedlescombe-Bexhill College
College days only
Operated by Renown Coaches
Unchanged

Schooldays only
Operated by Rambler Coaches
Unchanged except that the 382 operates to Rye in the afternoons
instead of to Brede
- Service 384 Silverhill-Helenswood-Beauport Park-Robertsbridge Community
College.
Schooldays only
Operated by Renown Coaches
Unchanged but with a fares increase to help recover part of the high
cost of provision
- Service 395 Little Common-Bexhill-Catsfield-Battle
Mondays to Saturdays
To be operated by Renown Coaches with low floor easy access buses
On Mondays to Fridays service revised to operate from Bexhill to
Battle via Catsfield and extended to Ashdown House and Conquest
hospital. The section of route from Little Common to Bexhill is
covered by Service 97 (see above under Service 303). On Saturdays
the service is reduced to 2 hourly and will maintain the existing route.

College Days only
To be operated by Smiths of Brenzett
Service will not serve the Hastings urban area
