7	For what purpose or project is the grant requested?	The grant is requested for The Music Well's music therapy provision, enabling children and young people in Rye to access sessions with a state registered clinical music therapist. Following on from the death of 7 year old Mary Shipstone in 2014 at the hand of her father, we have provided this service for children who would otherwise not afford it and who have suffered trauma, abuse and mental health issues. Mary's mother said that the music therapy sessions Mary had received as a response to the trauma caused by her abusive father, had been the most helpful intervention they had received.

		A course of music therapy sessions costs £400 per child to include provision of a music room, instruments, reports and liaison with parents/carers.
8	What will be the total cost of the project?	We would like to raise £16000 to cover music therapy service to local schools.

9	If the total cost of the project is more than the grant requested, how will the remainder be financed?	Ongoing fundraising, events (we have a fund raising concert with Liane Carroll in May, an Open Garden in July) and requesting contributions towards sessions where this is possible. We can only provide support to families and young people when we have raised the funds to do so.

The benefit that each child/young person gains from sessions tends to generate outwards to family/carers/ peers and enables better focus on their life and education with better life outcomes.</p> <p>The Music Well has been providing a music therapy service to the children and young people of Rye for nearly 8 years now and there is plenty of testimony to its effectiveness.</p>

ON balance it can be seen that these children have improved during the course of the Music Therapy sessions, particularly in areas of emotional and language development with most children showing improved scores for self confidence, reducing anxiety, sustaining attention, relating and communication skills. It is hoped that the outcomes as demonstrated above from music therapy will underpin a child's confidence and ability to learn, thereby taking full advantage of the opportunities offered him/her at school.
