

Rye Relief in Need Privacy Notice

Rye Relief in Need takes the protection of your data seriously. We regard your privacy as important and comply with the Data Protection Act 1998 and the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). Collecting some personal and sensitive information is necessary in order to fulfil the purpose of the charity. This notice explains how we use and share your information. Information may be collected on a paper or online form, by telephone, email or by a member of our staff. We record some personal and sensitive information if you apply for a grant for assistance from Rye Relief in Need.

We will not process any data relating to a child (under 13) without the express parental/guardian consent of the child concerned.

Your Rights

Access to Information

You have the right to request access to the information we have about you. You can do this by contacting Rye Relief in Need's Secretary via Rye Town Council.

Information Correction

Rights Related to Automated Decision Making and Profiling

We do not use profiling, we do not sell your data, we do not pass your data to third parties without your consent. We do not use your data for purposes other than those specified. We make sure your data is stored securely. We delete all information deemed to be no longer necessary. We constantly review our Privacy Policies to keep it up to date in protecting your data.
