### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State gives notice of the proposal to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of a length of Rock Channel, a length of Public Footpath Rye 32c, and a length of Public Footpath Rye 33, in the District of Rother.

If made, the Order would authorise the stopping up only to enable development as permitted by Rother District Council, under reference RR/2019/789/P.
